

2018 WOJFC - Coach Code of Conduct

1A: This is to notify each Coach or Sideline Personnel of any WOJFC player at any WOJFC event or game, that if they receive an Unsportsmanlike Penalty, they will not attend any team practice for two days. They will sign a new Coaches Code of conduct and that contract will also be signed by the Organization President. They must submit the contract to the WOJFC Competition Director within 5 days of penalty. The coach can't attend a practice or game until this is accomplished. If the same coach or Sideline Personnel receive an additional Unsportsmanlike Penalty during another contest in the same season they are immediately suspended for one Week. They will take the NFHS on-line course 14-2 for "Teaching and Modeling Behavior" course, which must be completed no later than 12 days from time of ejection and can be taken at www.nfhslearn.com. They will pay all costs associated with the course. They will sign a new Coaches Code of conduct and that contract will also be signed by the Organization President. Contract and certificate of completion from the on-line course must be submitted to the WOJFC Competition Director within 12 days of removal or ejection. You may not attend any WOJFC event until all requirements are met within this paragraph. They must submit the contract to the WOJFC Competition Director within 12 days of the ejection penalty. If they receive any additional Unsportsmanlike Penalties during any WOJFC contest they will be suspended for 2 games and will have to attend the next Monday meeting and the WOJFC Board will determine if they can remain coaching for the remainder of the season. No individual or organizational appeals.

1B: This is to notify each Coach or Sideline Personnel of any WOJFC Organization at any WOJFC event or game. If a coach is removed or ejected from any WOJFC event or contest you are not allowed re-entrance to any WOJFC event the rest of the day. They are suspended from any WOJFC event for 12 day's, they are to follow 14-2 of OHSAA Rules and Regulations. They will take the NFHS on-line course for "Teaching and Modeling Behavior" course, which must be completed no later than 12 days from time of ejection and can be taken at www.nfhslearn.com. They will pay all costs associated with the course. They will sign a new Coaches Code of conduct and that contract will also be signed by the Organization President. Contract and certificate of completion from the on-line course must be submitted to the WOJFC Competition Director within 12 days of removal or ejection. You may not attend any WOJFC event until all requirements are met within this paragraph. No individual or organizational appeals.

1C: If any Coach or Sideline Personnel, of any WOJFC Organization, attending any WOJFC event or game, is removed or ejected from a WOJFC event for a second time within the same season. They will be suspended from coaching any WOJFC game for the remainder of the season and tournament. The following season the individual may apply for re-instatement to coach in the WOJFC. They must submit an application in no less than 100 words, what they are doing to prevent any future bad behavior. They

must also submit a \$50.00 re-instatement fee. They must get a letter from the Organization to which they belong, that the Board of that organization has approved them for re-instatement as a coach for that organization. The application, fee and Organizational letter are submitted to the WOJFC Competition Director. A date will be scheduled for them to attend a WOJFC Board Meeting and present their case for re-instatement. No Individual or Organization appeals

Guidelines for following UNSL penalties

1. Only first UNSL - 2 day practice suspension administered by organization and new Coaches Code of Conduct signed by coach and president and given to WOJFC Communication Director (fax or mail) filed

2. Second UNSL by same coach - 1 week suspension all WOJFC activities. New Coaches Code of Conduct signed by Coach and President, coach takes OHSAA Behavioral Course. Must submit new Coaches Code of Conduct and Certificate of Behavioral Course, to WOJFC Communication Director within 12 days. If not within 12 days coach remains suspended from all WOJFC activities.

3. Coach or sideline personnel ejected from game.- 1 week suspension all WOJFC activities. New Coaches Code of Conduct signed by Coach and President, coach takes OHSAA Behavioral Course. Must submit new Coaches Code of Conduct and Certificate of Behavioral Course, to WOJFC Communication Director within 12 days. If not within 12 days coach remains suspended from all WOJFC activities.

4. Coach or Sideline Personnel ejected for second time.- Suspended as coach for remainder of season and will follow 1C to re-apply to coaching at beginning of following season. Coach can attend games as a parent, but at discretion of organization can be suspended from games. .

5. Parent or Fan ejection - 1 week suspension from all WOJFC activities. New Parent Code of Conduct signed by Parent and President, Parent or fan takes OHSAA Behavioral Course. Must submit new Coaches Code of Conduct and Certificate of Behavioral Course, to WOJFC Communication Director within 12 days. If not within 12 days coach remains suspended from all WOJFC activities. If Home Site Rep ejects Parent or Fan they must do game sheet right up.

6. Parent or Fan Second ejection - Suspended as parent or fan for remainder of season and will follow 1C to re-apply to attending WOJFC activities at beginning of following season.

Note: The WOJFC will file all UNSL penalties and ejections by organization. This will make tracking easy for the WOJFC Board for which Coaches or Fans are under these rules. All UNSL penalties and ejections will be on game report. So Director will know who is expected to submit paperwork. Competition Director will no longer issue paperwork TO organizations for ejections. Organizations are responsible to know if coaches need to submit paperwork to WOJFC for their coaches to coach. Any Coach, Parent, Guardian, or Fan suspended by organization for conduct during a WOJFC event must follow above ejection procedures.
